## Numismatic Currency List

The list below details coins and paper currency that, if found in an unclaimed safe deposit box, should be remitted to the Department in their original form, due to their numismatic, or collectible value.

## Numismatic Coins-United States

a. All uncirculated coins, regardless of date, denomination of condition;
b. All mint coins, regardless of date, denomination or condition;
c. All proof coins, regardless of date, denomination or condition;
d. All coins that appear to be part of a collection or set, regardless of date, denomination or condition;
e. All mounted coins, such as in a sleeve or book, regardless of date, denomination or condition;
f. All gold or gold-like coins;
g. Pennies (\$.01) dated 1960 and prior, regardless of condition;
h. Nickels (\$.05) dated 1960 and prior, regardless of condition;
i. Dimes (\$.10) dated 1964 and prior, regardless of condition;
j. Quarters (\$.25) dated 1976 and prior, regardless of condition;
k. Half Dollars (\$.50) dated 1976 and prior, regardless of condition; and
I. All Dollar Coins, regardless of date and condition.

## Numismatic Coins-Foreign (Not U.S.)

All foreign coins, regardless of date, denomination, country of origin or condition.

## Numismatic Paper Currency-United States

a. All uncirculated bills, regardless of date, denomination or condition;
b. All mint or unissued bills, regardless of date, denomination or condition;
c. All bills that appear to be part of a collection or set, regardless of date, denomination or condition;
d. All mounted bills, such as in a sleeve or book, regardless of date, denomination or condition;
e. One Dollar Bills $(\$ 1.00)$ dated 1963 and prior, regardless of condition;
f. Two Dollar Bills (\$2.00) dated 1976 and prior, regardless of condition;
g. Five Dollar Bills ( $\$ 5.00$ ) dated 1977 and prior, regardless of condition;
h. Ten Dollar Bills (\$10.00) dated 1969 and prior, regardless of condition;
i. Twenty Dollar Bills (\$20.00) dated 1950 and prior, regardless of condition;
j. Fifty Dollar Bills (\$50.00) dated 1950 and prior, regardless of condition;
k. One Hundred Dollar Bills (\$100.00) dated 1966 and prior, regardless of condition; and
I. All Five Hundred Dollar (\$500.00), One Thousand Dollar (\$1,000.00), and Ten Thousand Dollar ( $\$ 10,000.00$ ) Bills, regardless of date or condition.

Numismatic Bills-Foreign (Not U.S.)
All Foreign bills, regardless of date, denomination, country of origin or condition.
